GREETING

WHEREAS The Corporations Act, 1953 provides that with the exceptions therein mentioned the Lieutenant-Governor may in his discretion, by Letters Patent, issue a Charter to any number of persons, not less than three, of twenty-one or more years of age who apply therefor, constituting them and any others who become shareholders or members of the corporation thereby created a corporation for any of the objects to which the authority of the Legislature extends;

AND WHEREAS by the said Act it is further provided that the Provincial Secretary may in his discretion and under the Seal of his office have, use, exercise and enjoy any power, right or authority conferred by the said Act on the Lieutenant-Governor;

AND WHEREAS by their Application in that behalf the persons herein named have applied for the issue of a Charter constituting them a corporation for the due carrying out of the undertaking hereinafter set forth;

AND WHEREAS it has been made to appear that the said persons have complied with the conditions precedent to the issue of the desired Charter and that the said undertaking is within the scope of the said Act;

NOW THEREFORE KNOW YE that under the authority of the hereinbefore in part recited Act I DO BY THESE LETTERS PATENT issue a Charter to the Persons hereinafter named that is to say:

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R o g e p A s s i m, Clergyman; S a k r i a M a l i k,  
Statistician; and A m i M e r i m, Proprietor; all of the City  
of Toronto, in the County of York and Province of Ontario;  
constituting them and any others who become members of the  
Corporation hereby created a corporation without share capital under  
the name of

M U S L I M S O C I E T Y O F T O R O N T O I N C .

for the following objects, that is to say:

- (a) TO establish, maintain and conduct a society for the teaching and instruction of its members in the fundamental and moral principles of Muslim;
- (b) TO aid in the establishment of Muslim immigrants in Canada and to teach the said immigrants the laws and customs of Canada;
- (c) TO conduct public or private meetings and to establish, maintain and conduct classes for Muslim education and to employ ~~instructors~~ therefor;
- (d) TO print, publish, sell and distribute literature of every nature and kind and to establish and operate printing plants for such purposes; and
- (e) TO receive, acquire and hold gifts, donations, devises and bequests and membership dues set by the majority of the members;

THE HEAD OFFICE of the Corporation to be situate at the said City of Toronto; and

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THE FIRST DIRECTORS of the Corporation to be Nagop Assin, Sakria  
Malik and Sami Kerim, heretofore mentioned;

AND IT IS HEREBY OBTAINED AND DECLARED that the Corporation shall be  
carried on without the purpose of gain for its members and any profits  
or other accretions to the Corporation shall be used in promoting its  
objects;

AND IT IS HEREBY FURTHER OBTAINED AND DECLARED that upon the  
dissolution of the Corporation and after the payment of all debts and  
liabilities, the remaining property of the Corporation shall be  
distributed or disposed of to charitable organizations or to  
organizations the objects of which are beneficial to the community.
