To all to whom these Presents shall come
Greeting

Whereas *The Corporations Act provides that with the exceptions therein mentioned the Lieutenant Governor may in his discretion, by Letters Patent, issue a Charter to any number of persons, not fewer than three, of ~~twenty one~~ ^{eighteen} or more years of age, who apply therefor, constituting them and any others who become shareholders or members of the corporation thereby created a corporation for any of the objects to which the authority of the Legislature extends;*

And Whereas *by the said Act it is further provided that the member of the Executive Council to whom the administration of this Act is assigned may in his discretion and under the Seal of his office have, use, exercise and enjoy any power, right or authority conferred by the said Act on the Lieutenant Governor;*

And Whereas *it has been made to appear that the persons herein named have complied with the conditions precedent to the issue of the desired Charter and that the said undertaking is within the scope of the said Act;*

Now Therefore Know Ye *that, being the member of the Executive Council to whom the administration of this Act is assigned, I do by these Letters Patent issue a Charter to the Persons hereinafter named that is to say:*

Sirajuddin Ahmad, of the Borough of North York, in The Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto, in the Province of Ontario, Civil Engineer; Abdulhai Sulaiman Patel, of the said The Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto, Electronics Service Representative; and Attaul Haq Malick, of the City of Montreal, in the Province of Quebec, Design Engineer; constituting them and any others who become members of the Corporation hereby created a corporation without share capital under the name of

MUSLIM STUDENTS ASSOCIATIONS, ISLAMIC
SERVICES OF CANADA

for the following objects, that is to say:

- (a) TO help new Muslim students get familiarized with Canadian laws and customs and adjust to Canadian life;
- (b) TO provide educational, cultural and religious services;
- (c) TO arrange prayer meetings;
- (d) TO promote friendly relations among students of different faiths;
- (e) TO provide books, libraries and reading room services;
- (f) TO arrange lectures, seminars, camps and conferences in order to make Islam better understood;
- (g) TO arrange hostel accommodations;
- (h) TO arrange visits to hospitals to look after sick students and to help them in their period of convalescence; and

(1) TO further co-operation with existing Muslim organizations;

THE HEAD OFFICE of the Corporation to be situate in the said Borough of North York; and

THE FIRST DIRECTORS of the Corporation to be Sirajuddin Ahmad, Abdulhai Sulaiman Patel and Ataul Haq Malick, hereinbefore mentioned;

AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND DECLARED that the Corporation shall be carried on without the purpose of gain for its members and any profits or other accretions to the Corporation shall be used in promoting its objects;

AND IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDAINED AND DECLARED that, upon the dissolution of the Corporation and after the payment of all debts and liabilities, its remaining property shall be distributed or disposed of to charitable organizations which carry on their work solely in Canada;

AND IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDAINED AND DECLARED that the directors shall serve as such without remuneration, and no director shall directly or indirectly receive any

profit from his position as such; provided that a director may be paid reasonable expenses incurred by him in the performance of his duties.
